BLOOMINGFOODS RAISES OVER \$100,000 FOR LOCAL NONPROFITS

BLOOMINGTON, Ind. – The Bloomington-based cooperative Bloomingfoods has raised \$100,313 this year for several recipients through its Positive Change fundraising campaign.

[The Positive Change](#) campaign allows active owner-members of the co-op choose the Bloomington or Monroe County-based recipients for donations. Shoppers can then round-up their total to the nearest dollar amount, with proceeds benefiting the chosen nonprofit.
